The North East Windsport Club (NEWC), Australian Sailing and State Associations, & the Australian Blokarting Association endorse the following code of conduct for members.

As a direct or affiliated member of any of the organisations listed above, all members should meet the following standard of conduct:

- 1. Respect the rights, dignity and worth of others.
- 2. Be fair, considerate and honest in all dealing with others.
- 3. Be professional in, and accept responsibility for your actions.
- 4. Make a commitment to providing quality service.
- 5. Be aware of and maintain an uncompromising adhesion to North East Windsports Club standards, rules, regulations and policies.
- 6. Operate within the rules of the sport including NEWC, national and international guidelines that govern wind sport activities undertaken by the club.
- 7. Do not use your involvement with NEWC, Australian Sailing, or State Association to promote your own beliefs, behaviours or practices where these are inconsistent with those of the relevant organisation.
- 8. Demonstrate a high degree of individual responsibility towards all people and especially when dealing with persons under 18 years of age, as your words and actions are an example.
- 9. Avoid unaccompanied and unobserved activities with persons under 18 years of age, wherever possible.
- 10. Refrain from any form of harassment of others.
- 11. Refrain from any behaviour that may bring NEWC, Australian Sailing or State Association or NEWC into disrepute.
- 12. Provide a safe environment for the conduct of NEWC's activity.
- 13. Show concern and caution towards others who may be sick or injured.
- 14. Be a positive role model.
- 15. Understand the repercussions if you breach, or are aware of any breaches of this Code of Conduct or NEWC Policy.
